



An overview of our SEND policy

WAVE 1 – this is what every child a Discovery Primary School receives every day.



All staff are responsible for Wave 1 provision and adjustments will be made for the needs of the children.



Class teacher to consider whether additional intervention is necessary, using their assessments

WAVE 2 – some children may need a little support



If a child is not making appropriate progress or not achieving age related expectations despite some modifications to Wave 1, they may need a specific, time bound intervention to overcome their barriers to learning.

Interventions are monitored by the SENCo and entry and exit data is collected to monitor the impact.



SENCo, in consultation with the parent, to complete SEN referral forms to outside agencies

WAVE 3 - On-going, specific support to address a child's special educational needs



A child may need additional support from another in the room as well as support from outside agencies. They will have an individual target book and meetings will be held with the parents to discuss these.

SENCo responsible for liaising with outside agencies, gathering information and data and completing any paperwork.
SENCo to apply for EHCP if required.

At every stage the parents/carers are kept informed and are involved with decision making.
